- It offers comprehensive facilities and services under one roof, facilitating easy access for the farming community.
- The program fosters collective problem-solving among farmers through linkages with government agencies, focusing on skill enhancement and ensuring timely access to inputs to prevent shortages and black marketing.
- Governed by a board chaired by the Secretary Agriculture KP government, it operates as a volunteer-driven, public-private partnership, with shared financing from the KP government.
- Agritech Limited collaborated with MFSCs to supply Tara urea to numerous FSCs in KP during critical shortages in the 2023-24 seasons, earning appreciation from officials and farmers alike.
